2. Matters Arising

Printers and Eduroam

The council was informed that

- printers were not working at certain parts of campus, the color printers usually do not work which requires students to incur costs from printing off-campus and that printers were incorrectly taking students' credits

- eduroam was not stable around campus and at times eduroam kicks students out of the network
- The resolution was that the Academic Councilor would give direction on what can be done by council members to assist her in resolving the issues.

3. Housekeeping

- Council members were urged to share SRC statements and posters with substructures. Council members voiced their concerns about flooding substructures with information and suggested that SRC statements and posters could be sent by head students through the Academic Councilor. This was adopted by the council.
- The Secretary General would be on leave and unavailable from the 24th of April 2022 to the 3rd of May 2022; the International Councilor would step in as the Secretary General. The Activism and Transformation Councilor would be on leave and unavailable from the 25th of April to the 3rd of May 2022; the Executive was yet to select her replacement.

4. Feedback

Intervarsity

- The date would be the 5th to 6th of August 2022 and a budget of R100 000.
- There was a general consensus that the Projects Councilor would create a google document so that the council could brainstorm ideas for intervarsity.

5. Visual Statements

- It was explained that council members would show sneak peeks of their upcoming events in a video to be shared on social media.
- To keep on track to release the first video on the 1st of May 2022, council members would begin shooting for their upcoming plans after they have submitted their updated year plans on the 22nd of April 2022.

6. SRC Media Policy

- The media team would be meeting on Friday, the 22nd of April 2022 to adopt the policy.

Q & A session

- It was explained that by using stickers, students would ask questions and council members would reply using the SRC stories and this would be saved under highlights. Each portfolio would have a week dedicated to them. Facebook and Instagram would be used.
- There was a general consensus that students would get to ask questions on Mondays and Tuesdays and the responses from council members would be due on Fridays.

7. Earth Day

- It was confirmed that the transport would leave at 12:30 and return at 14:00. Council members were requested to confirm their availability by 11 am on Thursday the 21st of April. Council members would still need to provide a sufficient reason for their absence.
- There was a general consensus to wear the black golf t-shirts as the purple t-shirts were unavailable. Furthermore, the black golf t-shirt could be worn with sneakers given the type of event it was.

8. Faculty Representatives

- Faculty representatives would be announced and the Academic Councilor would have a meeting with them next week.
- Council members enquired about the missing faculties. It was explained that the by-elections were not conducted as the policy consideration was coming up.
- The council inquired about the election process of one of the representatives and whether the IEB had been involved in these processes. The Academic Councilor stated that she set to receive a document on how the election process was conducted in that election.

9. Other Matters Arising
